SURVIVOR SUPPORT SERVICES

At the EmBark Foundation, we provide services that support both survivors and their furry friends. Below is a short description of each service that we offer. Upon approval of your application, you will receive an introductory packet that more thoroughly outlines the service and the process.

Adoption-Related Services

Adoption of a Rescue Animal

We fund the adoption of any cat or dog from an official rescue or shelter. We do not fund for animals that are purchased from an "animart", pet store, or breeder. The rescue does not have to be a partner of ours as we will work with any accredited shelter or rescue to fund the adoption.

Adoption Packages

A New Leash on Life Adoption Package:

Rescue animal adoption + pet supplies package

New Friends, Forever Family Adoption Package:

Rescue animal adoption + Emotional Support Animal (ESA) certification.

EmBark on a Journey of Healing Adoption Package:

Rescue animal adoption + Emotional Support Animal (ESA) certification + pet supplies package.

Non-Adoption-Related Services

Emotional Support Animal (ESA) Certification

ESA's can be obtained through your therapist or credible sites, such as certapet.com. Some therapists charge a fee to write an ESA letter while others do not. Whether it is a letter from a therapist or a letter from a credible site like certapet.com, we fund for both!

Pet Supplies Package

We fund pet supplies as needed by the survivor. This can range from a new dog bed to dog food to a cat tower. We fund for these packages by taking your requested items and ordering them on our end. We do not reimburse for supplies that have already been purchased.

Veterinary Visit Reimbursement

We fund for annual vet visits as well as emergency vet visits within our financial guidelines and policies. We fund for veterinary visits upon retrieval of the official receipt from the visit.

Survivor Care Package

We fund care packages for survivors (even if you don't have an animal!). These packages normally contain self-care items, comfy clothes, hobby items, and more. What you want in your package is completely up to you!
